Gift Aid Declaration

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, Off The Fence will receive an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make and it doesn't cost you a thing.

You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donation in the tax year (at least 28p for each £1 you give).3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration.4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.5.
