

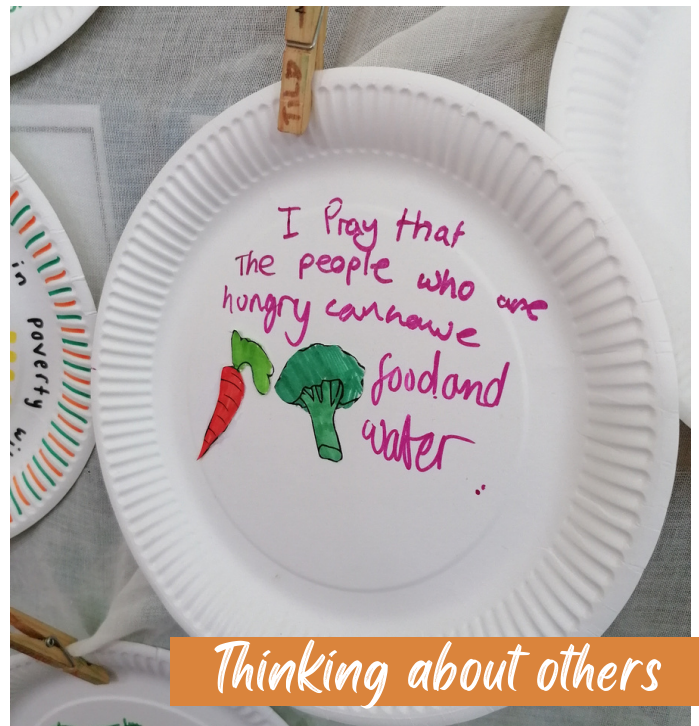

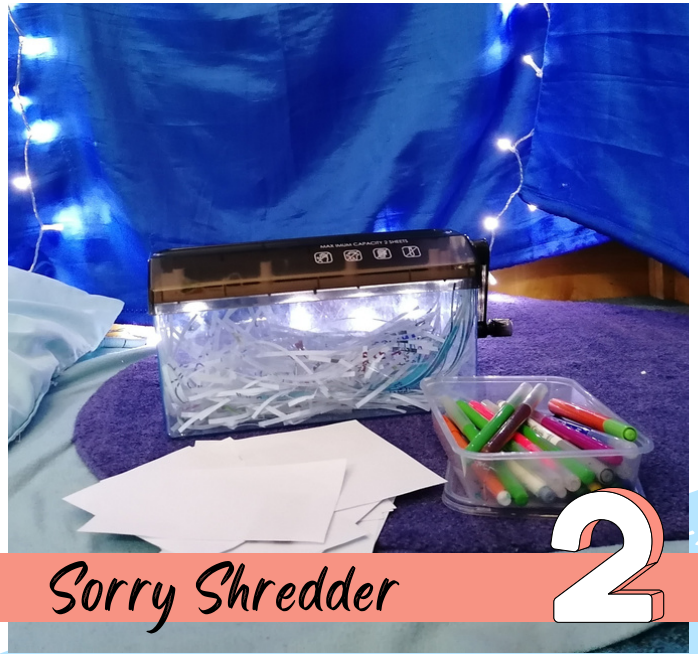

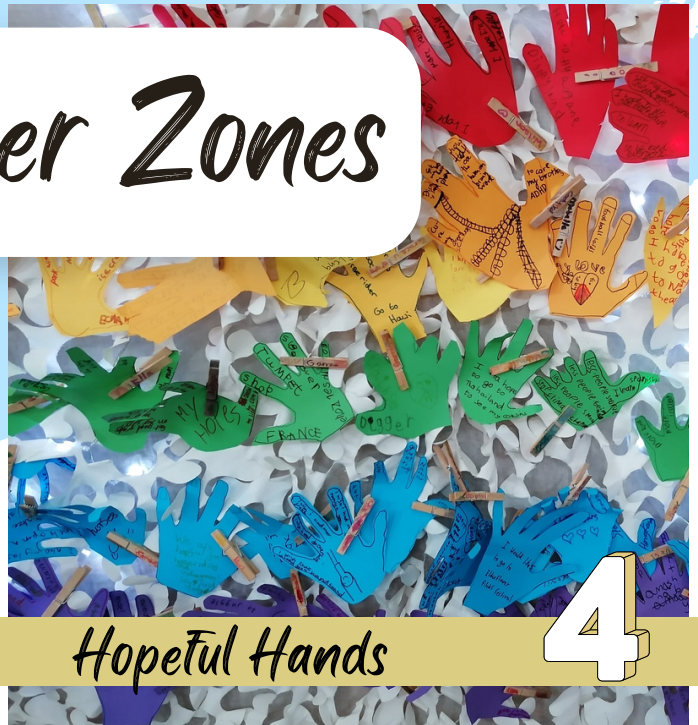

1 Thank You Ducks

THIS WAS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS TO WRITE DOWN ANY QUESTIONS THEY HAD, BIG OR SMALL, WITHOUT FEAR OF JUDGEMENT OR REPRIMAND.

3 Big Questions

THIS ACTIVITY HELPED STUDENTS TO THINK ABOUT ALL THE AMAZING THINGS THAT MAKE THEM WHO THEY ARE. IT WAS ALSO AN OPPORTUNITY TO THINK ABOUT THE GOOD THINGS GOD SEES WHEN HE LOOKS AT THEM.

5 Who Am I?

STUDENTS WERE ENCOURAGED TO CONSIDER THINGS THEY MAY NEED TO SAY SORRY FOR AND THEN WROTE THESE ON A SLIP OF PAPER. THEY THEN SHREDED THE PAPER WHILE THINKING ABOUT GOD'S FORGIVENESS.

2 Sorry Shredder

STUDENTS DREW AROUND THEIR HAND AND THEN WROTE 5 THINGS THEY WERE HOPEFUL FOR. THEIR COLOURFUL HAND PRINT WAS THEN PEGGED UP TO MAKE A BIG COLOURFUL RAINBOW.

4 Hopetful Hands

THIS ACTIVITY GAVE STUDENTS TIME TO STOP FOR A MOMENT AND WATCH A SHORT VIDEO STORY FROM THE BIBLE. THEY THEN TALKED ABOUT WHAT THEY SAW AND WHAT THOUGHTS THE STORY INSPIRED.
